We work very closely with local youth groups, Wandsworth Borough Council youth services and young offending teams to reach those people most in need. This year we had over 2,500 day trips to numerous destinations. As ever trips to the beach were very popular and enjoyed by all. For many this was a first and there was a lot of laughter. Shells were collected and splashy paddling encouraged! Adventure Island with its associated beach was again well visited. Other activities included outdoor challenge courses, water challenge venues, rock climbing trampolining and skiing. Also GoApe in Battersea Park which was generously donated by them.

This year we had two residentials to a farm in Devon, two trips to Bewl Water with lots of water based activities and to an activity centre in Buckinghamshire. For many this is their first time away from home and it is a great opportunity to boost their confidence and interact positively with both peers and mentors. They take on challenging activities which broaden their horizons and develop their independence and confidence.

HENRIETTA CROKER POOLE MBE



The Trustees were saddened in October by the death of an indefatigable and gracious founder Panel Member, Henrietta Croker Poole MBE. She devised and ran the ambitious Summer Scheme in 1988 which increased in size, scope and content every year and provided summer and other challenging activities for some 5'000 young and teenagers of the area. She was also a founder of the fundraising Battersea Ball which grew to raise in excess of £55,000 a year. She remained a key member of the Panel till she died. Her commitment and endeavours were recognised through the Person of the Year Award by Wandsworth Council and subsequently the MBE awarded by HM Queen Elizabeth II.
